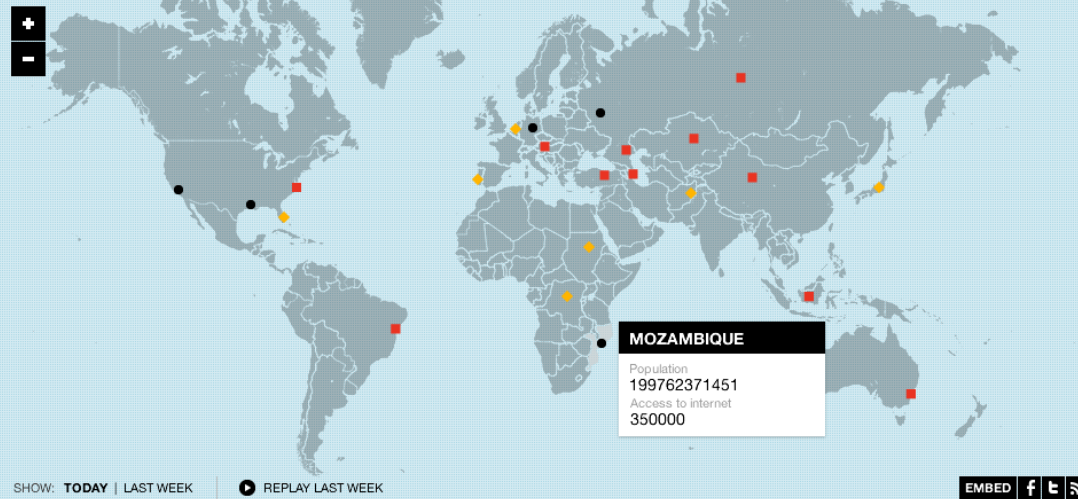

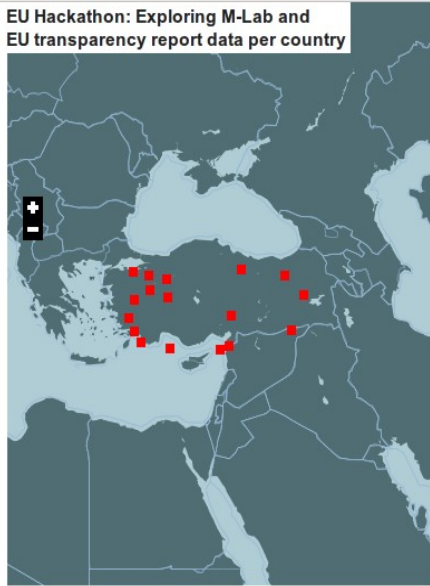

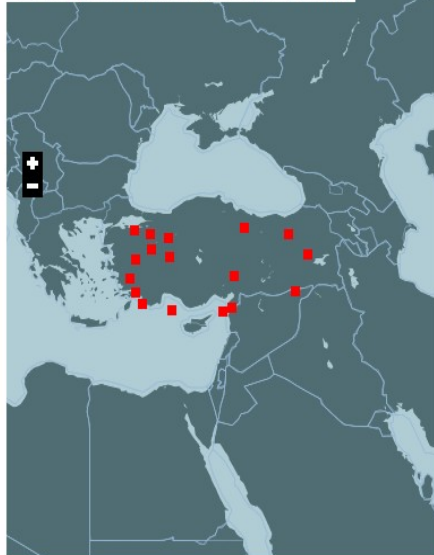

Between 2011-01-01 and 2011-06-30, Google received 1 request from executive organs (Police, etc.) to take down 6 items from Web Search citing "Government Criticism" as the main reason. Google complied by censoring 74% of the requested items.
